


Join the CREDIT4CE Research Commercialisation Programme

About the Programme

The CREDIT4CE Research Commercialization Program includes online workshops and networking opportunities that help academic staff, researchers, and university professionals develop the skills to turn research into practical solutions.

Why This Programme Matters

Central Europe has strong research capabilities - but many innovations fail to reach the market. Common barriers include limited exposure to market-driven thinking, uncertainty about IP ownership, lack of structured commercialisation pathways, and weak links among academia, industry, and investors.

This programme equips academics with the tools to **bridge this gap**.

Participants will gain knowledge they can apply to:

- their own research commercialisation journey
- supporting students and early-stage founders
- strengthening technology transfer within their institutions

What You Will Learn

Move research into the market via market analysis, IP assessment, and commercialisation routes.

Programme Impact

Participants will gain skills to assess the commercial potential of research, support spinout creation, and build stronger industry and investor collaborations.
